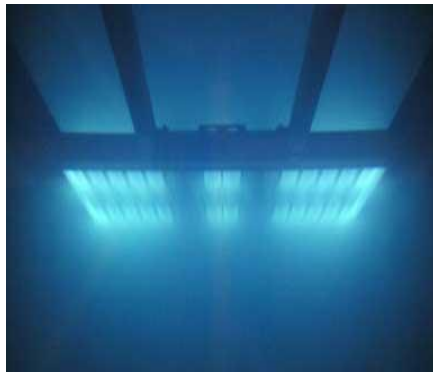
## Reasonable Assurance of Adequate Safety, Not Absolute Assurance of Perfect Safety

- Priority of leadership & prevalent throughout an organization



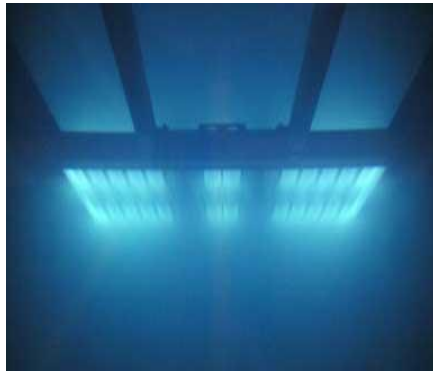
## Existing Risk-Informed Safety Culture

- Enhancement, but no huge pendulum shift needed



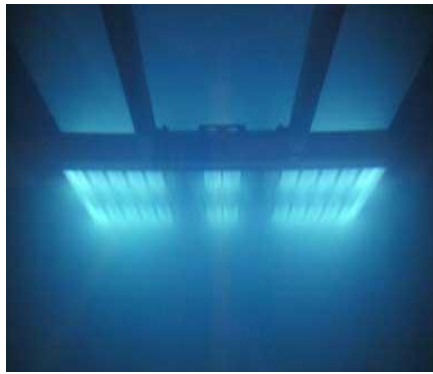
## Support of the Policy in Lieu of Formal Regulation

- Efficient and Effective



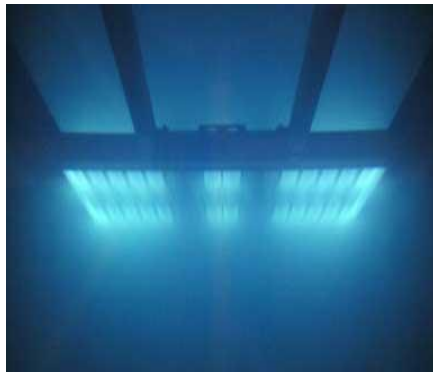
## AS Efforts on Informing Licensees
