IMC 1246

- Inspection Manual Chapter 1246
 - Reorganization in FY 2007 Created FSME
 - NMSS owns IMC 1246 – FSME will create its own IMC
 - Last Revision to License Reviewer and Inspector Qualifications was in January 2001
 - Revision will include general updates and changes
 - Incorporate IERP/MPWG recommendations

Working Group

- NRC Management Directive 5.3 Working Group Formed:
 - Began meeting on April 20, 2010
 - Membership includes FSME, Agreement States, Region I, and HRTD

Objectives

- Working Group has 4 Objectives
 - Incorporate Security Culture into qualifications
 - Update
 - Incorporate New Format
 - Classroom Training

Incorporating Security Culture

- Staff to become familiar with the different security requirements
- IC Course mandatory for Inspectors and License Reviewers
- Practice performing Pre-Licensing Guidance reviews
- Practice performing Security Inspections

Update

- Revise IMC 1246 to reflect new format and other changes
 - New Training
 - Familiarization with Security Requirements
 - Pre-Licensing Guidance
 - Refresher Training

New Format

- Combination of Individual Study Activities and On-the-Job Training Modules
- Embracing an Apprentice Style Approach
 - Emphasis on gaining practical experience in license reviews and inspections

Classroom Training

- Working Group solicited input from NRC Regions and Agreement States
 - Need for Additional Courses
 - Changes to any currently available courses

Health Physics Training

- The Working Group will consider available options for Health Physics Training
- 5-Week Course

Schedule

- Working Group expects to have the Inspection Manual Chapter to the Agreement States for a 30-day comment period in Fall 2010
- Expected completion of the Inspectional Manual Chapter is January 2011
