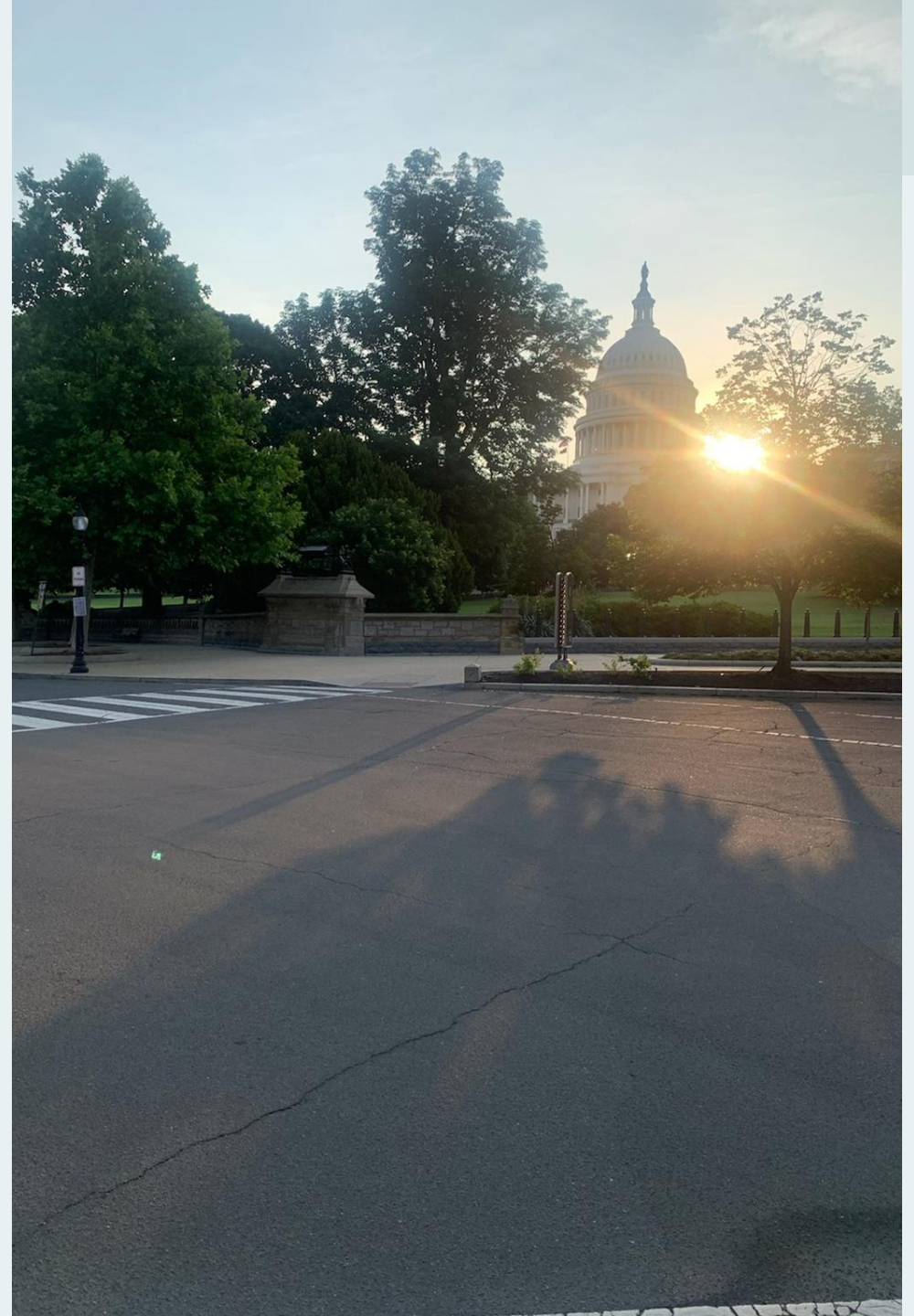

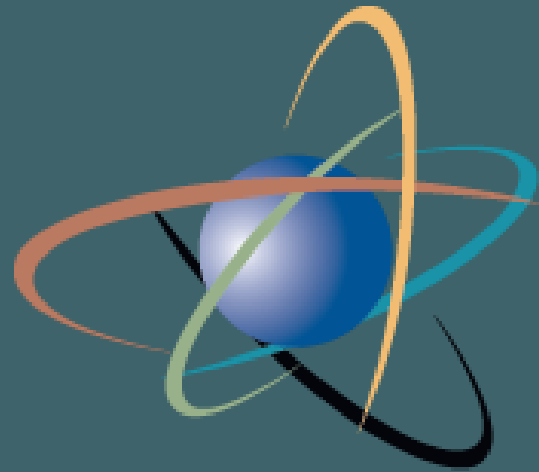

Director of Rulemaking: 13 letters to the NRC incorporating your comments on a variety of procedures and proposed rulemaking.

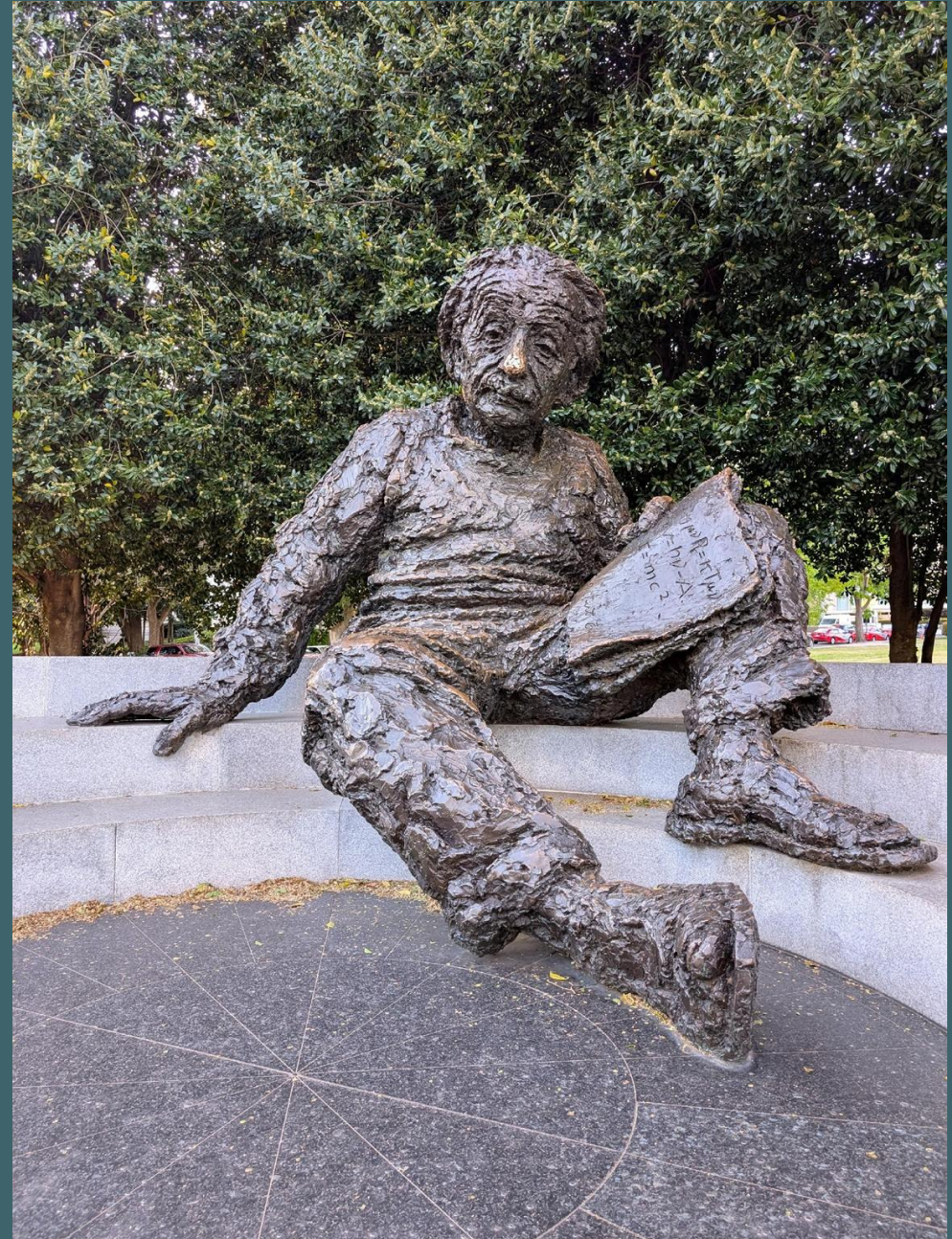
Director of Emerging Issues and Advocacy: 18 Joint Working Groups with 27 Total Agreement State Volunteers from 15 States.

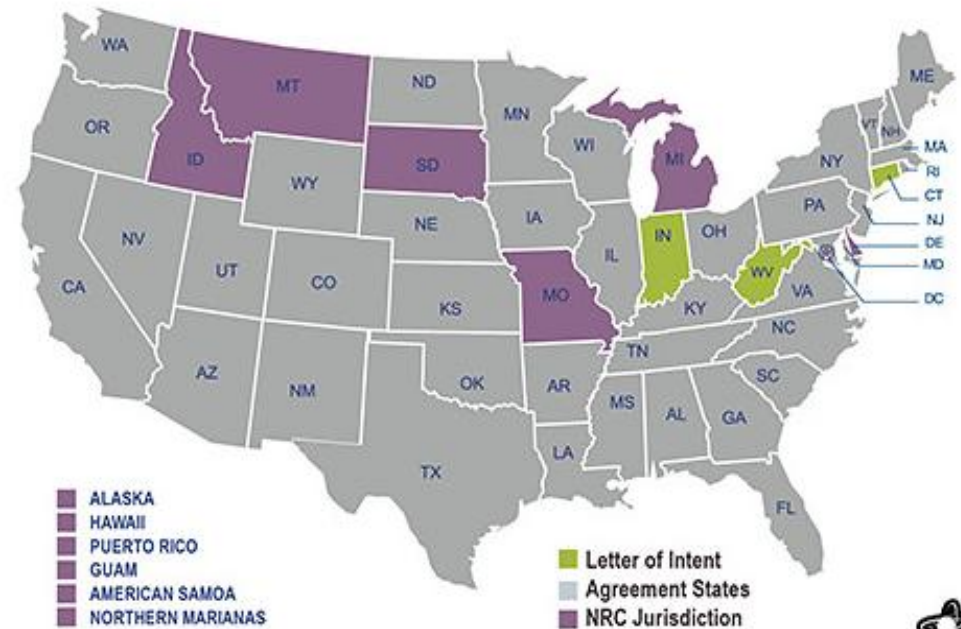

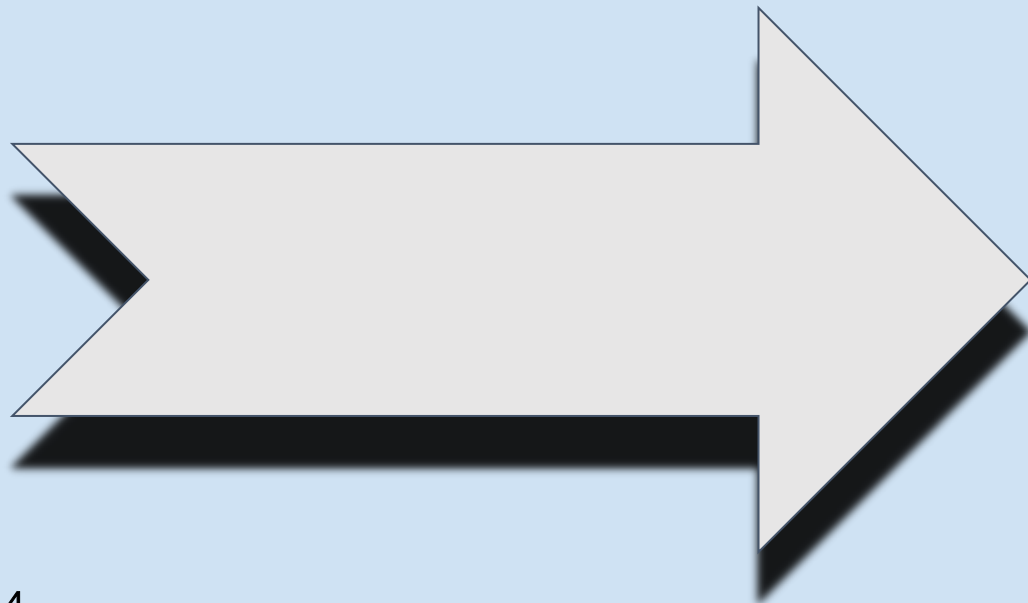


U.S. Agreement States

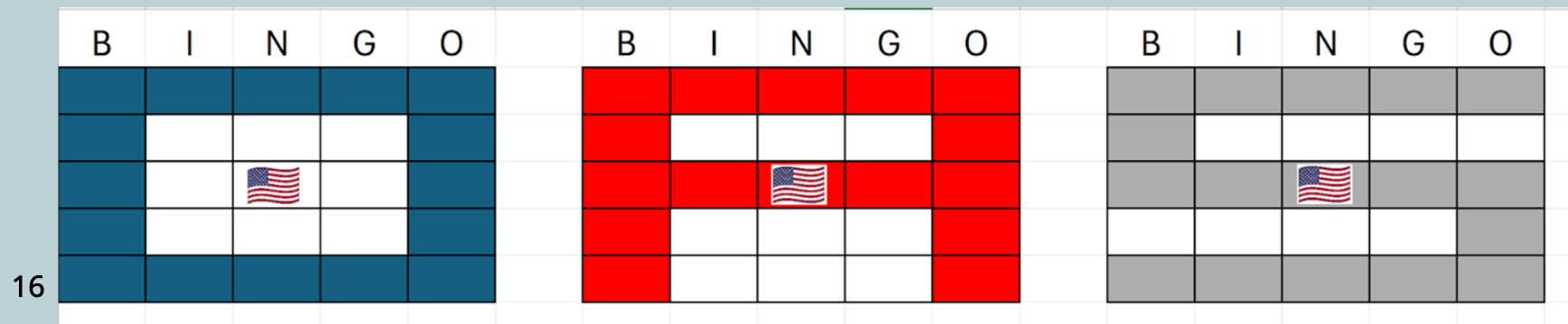
