Nuclear Regulator Apprenticeship Network Program (NRAN):

- Established as a means of hiring, developing, deploying, and retaining quality, well-rounded regulators with a focus on areas of agency skill need
- Provide a range of opportunities to develop technical and regulatory skills through mission-direct, task-focused apprenticeships.
 - 18-month training program
 - (3) 5-month long apprenticeships



Work assignments in TN included:

- Incident Response (Dumpster Dive)
- Radioactive material inspections
- Materials licensing reviews
- Tours of St. Jude Children's Hospital, Vanderbilt University Medical Center, and Energy Solutions.
- Environmental Sample Collection
- A nuclear power plant drill (field team)
